

Back to School in Dubai: Nanny or Governess?

NANNY OR GOVERNESS: WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE?

The right role begins with the right objective

A PROFESSIONAL NANNY

A Nanny is primarily responsible for a child's daily care and well-being. For younger children or families whose priority is consistent daily care, an experienced Nanny may be the most appropriate choice.

- Morning and bedtime routines
- School preparation and transportation
- Meals, personal care and nursery duties
- Age-appropriate activities and emotional development

A PROFESSIONAL GOVERNESS

A Governess has a stronger educational and developmental focus. She may work alongside parents, teachers and tutors to create continuity between school and home.

- Homework, study habits and academic organisation
- Language development and examination preparation
- Etiquette, social confidence and independence
- Communication with teachers and tutors

The correct appointment depends on the child's age, the family's expectations and the outcomes the professional will be responsible for delivering.

Structure at home supports progress at school

01 CONSISTENT ACADEMIC SUPPORT

Children benefit when learning does not stop at the school gate. A capable Governess can organise homework, reinforce classroom learning, coordinate with tutors and identify areas requiring additional support.

02 GREATER STABILITY AT HOME

Consistent morning, homework, meal and bedtime routines reduce unnecessary friction. When routines are managed calmly, the household becomes more predictable and children are better able to focus.

03 DEVELOPMENT BEYOND ACADEMICS

The right professional can help children strengthen their manners, communication, confidence, independence and respect for different cultures. These qualities influence how they conduct themselves at school, at home and socially.

A well-structured household routine gives children more space for curiosity, confidence and growth - and less exposure to avoidable school-term stress.

The professional supports the parents and school; she does not replace either.

An impressive CV is not enough

A candidate may have excellent qualifications and strong references but still be unsuitable for a particular household. A successful placement should also consider:

- The ages and personalities of the children
- The family's educational philosophy and household values
- Languages, cultural background and travel expectations
- Working hours, living arrangements and required autonomy
- Communication style and personality fit

Clear responsibilities are equally important. A Nanny should not automatically be expected to operate as a full-time tutor, Household Manager and Personal Assistant. A Governess should not be given several unrelated roles that prevent her from focusing on education and development.

The best results come from appointing the right professional to a clearly defined position.
