Fine textiles need controlled care

SILKS AND DELICATE FABRICS

Silks, lace and delicate fabrics should be protected from direct sunlight and unnecessary friction. Breathable, acid-free cotton garment covers are generally more suitable for long-term storage than plastic, which can trap moisture and restrict airflow.

CASHMERE, WOOL AND FINE KNITWEAR

Fine knitwear is normally folded flat on clean, smooth shelves. Incorrect hanging can stretch the fabric, distort the shoulders and permanently change the garment's shape.

EMBROIDERED COUTURE AND FINE LEATHER

Beaded garments require tissue buffering, specialist hangers or flat storage to avoid snagging and excess tension. Handbags and fine leather accessories should be protected from direct light, excess humidity and overcrowded shelving.

The objective is not simply to keep a wardrobe tidy. It is to preserve the condition, structure and long-term value of every piece.

Organisation protects the collection

01 SYSTEMATIC CATALOGUING AND INVENTORY CONTROL

A secure digital catalogue or detailed physical inventory can record each item's image, designer, care requirements, repair history and exact location. This helps principals plan outfits, manage multiple residences and track pieces sent for cleaning or alteration.

02 GARMENT ROTATION AND PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE

Professional wardrobe care is proactive. Regular inspections identify loose embellishments, damaged hems, unsuitable hangers, moisture concerns and early fabric deterioration before a minor issue becomes costly damage.

03 TRAVEL PACKING AND DESTINATION PREPARATION

A trained Lady's Maid or wardrobe professional plans around the destination, climate and itinerary. Garments are packed with suitable protective materials, inventoried for transit, then promptly inspected, steamed and organised upon arrival.

Professional packing does more than save time. It protects valuable garments throughout international travel and keeps the wardrobe presentation-ready.

The right system protects both the collection and the principal's time.

A general Housekeeper is not always a wardrobe specialist

A candidate may be highly capable in general housekeeping but have limited experience handling couture, rare fabrics, fine leather or bespoke garments. Luxury wardrobe management requires specialist knowledge, precision and absolute discretion.
